
How to adapt the Diamante® for a Pengad Tilt-Tripod.

The Diamante[®] has a metal plate attached to the bottom of the writer. By simply removing the screws which secure the plate, the plate can be removed allowing the use of any standard court reporter tripod. This process does not affect the functionality of the writer in any way.

There are four phillips head screws fastening the black plate to the bottom of the writer. Simply remove the screws and the plate, <u>being</u> <u>especially careful that the screws aren't accidentally</u> <u>dropped into the writer</u>. As an extra precaution, you may wish to have an assistant balance the writer on its side while the screws are removed.



Once the plate is removed, a standard style connector plate is revealed which can be used with any standard tripod.

It is suggested that you keep the plate and screws in a safe place.
